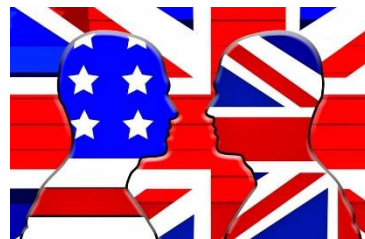
Nichole works 12 hours per week in this school, 5 hours with the vocational students and 7 in the general high school.
